11:30-12:15pm	Washing hands and Lunch time. *
12:15-2:00pm	Sleep / quiet time. Calming / relaxing music played in sleep room throughout.

### Busy Bee Daily Routine

7:30-8:30am	Breakfast and welcoming children into nursery.
8:25am-8:30am	Tidy away breakfast and demonstrate first and then
8:30-8:45am	Group time - sing the "Hello song" and discuss today's weather and counting. Staff to pass on any messages from parents.
8:45-10:55am	Free flow: access to all indoor activities. Activities are to relate to this week's topic plan. (adult led observation)
9:30-10:00am	Rolling snack.
10:00-10:45am	Key staff change key children nappies.
10:55-11:05am	Tidy up time (using first and then) - staff and children are to carry out the tidying whilst encouraging children to gain a good understanding of where resources are stored safely. Then split for group times.
11:05-11:10am	<b>Green Group;</b> Group time focused activity (singing dice to pass the parcel music) <b>Red Group;</b> Ring Games such as farmers in the den
11:10-11:30am	<b>Green Group;</b> Outdoor activities. <b>Red group;</b> Group focussed activity: talk about this week's topic, story and singing.
11:30-12:00am	<b>Green Group -</b> Lunch time: Wash hands with children sing hand washing time at the same time. Children are encouraged to serve themselves with support from staff if needed. Staff are to encourage healthy food-like conversations throughout whilst sitting with the children. <b>Red Group -</b> Outdoor activities. Hand over 12 o'clock parents
12:00- 1:30pm	<b>Red Group -</b> Lunch time: Wash hands with children sing hand washing time at the same time. Children are encouraged to serve themselves with support from staff if needed. Staff are to encourage healthy food-like conversations throughout whilst sitting with the children. Followed by quiet activities while children sleep. <b>Green Group-</b> Children sleep time.
1:30-1:35pm	Children to awake from sleep time and Tidy up time - staff and children are to carry out the tidying whilst encouraging children to gain a good understanding of where resources are stored safely.
1:35-2:00pm	Key workers change their key children nappies. Mirror morning group time Group time - sing the "Hello song" and discuss today's weather and counting. Staff to pass on any messages from parents.

2:00-2:45pm	Rolling snack (adult led activities)
2:30-3:00pm	Children leaving at 3:00pm to do some focused group activity outside. Children to do indoor adult led activities.
3:00-3:55pm	Outdoor activities using curriculum planning to lead activities outside.
4:00- 4:30pm	Teatime: wash hands and prep for tea. Children are encouraged to serve themselves with support from staff if needed. Staff are to encourage healthy food-like conversations throughout whilst sitting with the children. (nappies)
4:30-5:00pm	Group focussed activity: talk about this week's topic, story and singing, phonics sound of the week.
5:00 - 6:00pm	Free play & staff to deep clean (indoor and outdoor equipment/areas).
6:00pm	Handover and home time.

9:30-11:00am	Planned topic activities and free flow outdoors.
11:00-11:15am	Tidy up time and split into group times.
11:15-11:30am	Planned group times for red and green group.
11:30-12:00am	First sitting for dinner (younger group) Wash hands/toileting then outside play. children are encouraged to serve themselves with support from staff if needed. Staff are to encourage healthy food-like conversations throughout whilst sitting with the children. **
12:00 -1:00pm	Wash hands/toileting second group for dinner (older group)
1:00-1:40pm	Outdoor play/welcoming children.
1:40-2:00pm	Planned group time activities.
